The TXHAF program has targeted all HAF funding to homeowners with household income less than or equal to 100% of AMFI, or 100% of the median income for the United States, whichever is greater. Based on the demographics of the state and of TDHCA's Portfolio, targeting at this income level was projected to effectively serve those most in need, including homeowners considered to be socially disadvantaged. The overwhelmingly successful results of the **TXHAF** program to date have proven that the funding is flowing to a high percent of Persistent Poverty Counties and
